Create your own stained glass style artwork at home with artist Sophie Mahon.

You'll need:



Markers or thick felt tip pens



Things to draw around



Paper



Ruler



Vegetable oil



Sellotape

Process

- Will your artwork have a theme? Will you include text or symbols?
 Maybe you have a message you would like to share with your neighbour?
- Experiment by overlapping shapes to build up your design.
- Decide on the colours you would like to use, then colour in the different sections.
- Allow your marker pen ink to dry, then brush a little vegetable oil over the artwork. The oil will make your work translucent, like stained glass and create a reflection in your window!
- Before you tape it up, double check that it is fully dry. Be careful not to get oil on your clothes, the window or the window sill.

Tips

- You can use any paper for your artwork, white paper will make colours look the most bright.
- Why not try creating your artwork with another person?
- You could even make a series of artworks and create a giant collaborative stained glass style window!
- Remember your artwork might just brighten someone's day or make them think about something!
