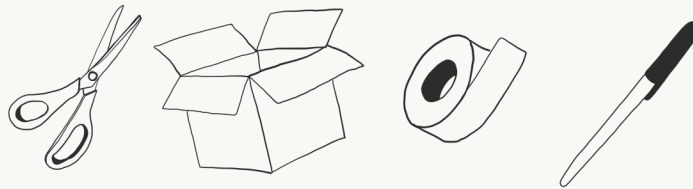


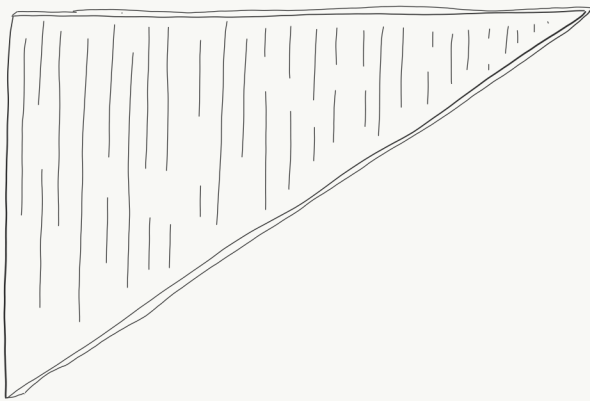
# CARDBOARD LANDSCAPES

Use your waste cardboard to make interesting cardboard landscapes.

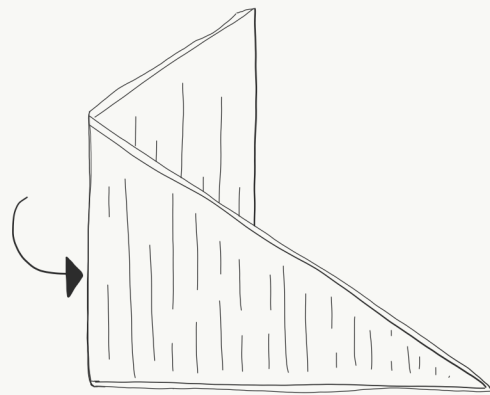
Materials: scissors, waste cardboard, glue or sticky tape and a black marker



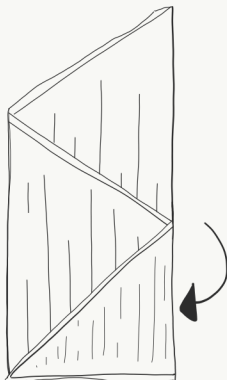
1. Cut your cardboard into a right angled triangle



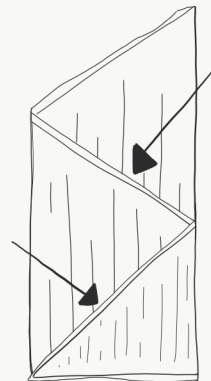
2. Fold the cardboard back roughly a third of the way along



3. Fold back the overhanging cardboard back

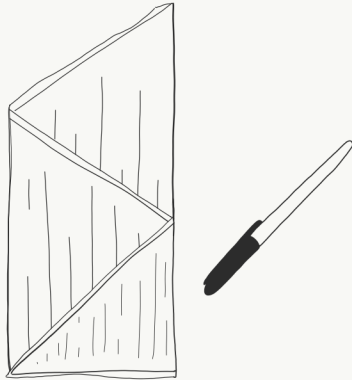


4. Secure with glue or tape

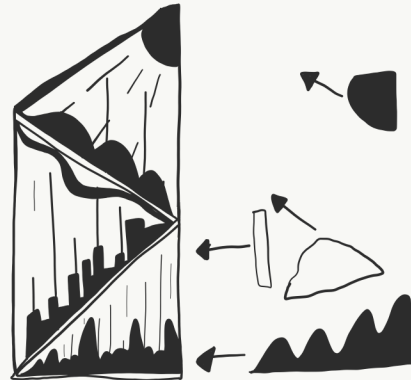

5. Decorate with black marker



6. Add extra details with scrap bits of cardboard
